- **WHO & UN Collaboration for Environmental Health**
- **14 - 18 May: Intergovernmental negotiations on the global compact for migration.** The intergovernmental negotiations on the global compact for migration will be held at the United Nations Headquarters in New York. Registration now open: multi-stakeholders in consultative status with ECOSOC and those with special accreditation to the GCM process are invited to register to attend all upcoming negotiations
- **21 May: Final informal interactive multi-stakeholder hearing on the global compact for migration.**
- The President of the General Assembly will convene a fifth and final informal interactive multi-stakeholder hearing as part of the preparatory process of the Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration (GCM). The hearing will take place on 21 May 2018 at 10:00 a.m. under the theme "Migration - What's Really Going On: Lessons from the field". It will provide representatives of non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations, academic institutions, parliaments, diasporas, migrants, migrant organizations and the private sector a forum to contribute by sharing and addressing lessons from local, national and regional activities related to the central issues being discussed in the negotiation of the GCM. Participation is open to all NGOs in Consultative Status with ECOSOC and organizations with special accreditation to the GCM preparatory process. - **30 May: High level Youth Dialogue convened by the PGA.**
- The President of the General Assembly will convene a high level Youth Dialogue on May 30 in the ECOSOC Chamber, UNHQ. The Youth Dialogue aims to listen to the ideas, needs and concerns of young people on bridging education and skills training with employment in the 21st century, as well as on the prevention of radicalization leading to violent extremism, in order to build a conversation between young people, ministers, permanent representatives, civil society representatives and others. The event further seeks to galvanize the efforts of many global alliances and initiatives that are empowering young people. The President of the General Assembly is seeking input from young people through his website and online surveys to shape this event.
